Kindergarten

1. School Bag (No wheels)
2. Folder - bottom pockets only
3. Crayons - 2 boxes of 8 and 2 boxes of 24 – Regular size
4. 4 -Elmer's glue - 4 oz.- white only
5. 4 Glue Sticks
6. 5 Pencils - yellow #2
7. Watercolors-Box of 8 - (Crayola/Prang)
8. Paper Towels - 2 rolls
9. 1 Large Container Wet Wipes
10. Large Box of Tissues
11. Markers (Crayola) – Regular size basic colors
12. Pink Eraser
13. Gallon ziploc bags - Girls
14. Quart size ziploc bags - Boys

Do Not Label

Grade 3

Individual Supplies (label with your child's name)

1. Pencil case (zipper)
2. 4 pencils and eraser
3. 24 crayons
4. 2 colored ink pens
5. 1 – 70 sheet spiral bound notebook to be used as a journal
6. 4 black dry erase markers

Shared supplies (DO NOT label with your child's name)

1. 12” wooden ruler with metric
2. Colored Pencils
3. 8 or 10 count of washable markers
4. 8 small or 2 large glue sticks
5. 1 pkg. white, wide lined paper
6. 1 box of tissues
7. Regular pointed scissors
8. 1 purple, blue, green, & yellow folder
9. 1 take home folder
10. 1 old sock for eraser
11. Scissors
12. 1 Elmer's Glue Bottle

Boys: 1 bag of snack size recloseable bags
1 roll of paper towels

Girls: 1 bag of sandwich size recloseable bags

8. 3 - #2 pencils or eversharps
9. Colored pencils
10. 1 box of Kleenex
11. Regular pointed scissors
12. Crayola water-based thick markers
13. Highlighter
14. 4 black dry erase markers
15. Sock to be used as an eraser
16. Small Zipped pencil bag
17. **Boys** – small baggies
18. **Girls** – Clorox wipes
19. **4th Grade only** – 100 page composition notebook

15. School bag – No wheels
16. Box of tissues
17. Box of quart Ziplock bags = Girls
18. Wet Wipes = Boys
