READ THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES CAREFULLY~

1. Failure to complete ALL sections (or falsifying information) may disqualify you from scholarship consideration.
2. Be sure to download the application before adding your information/printing.
3. Students are asked to provide financial information in the first section. We realize that many students are not eligible for Federal grants or loans, thus making their need for scholarships even greater, so it is to your advantage to file the FAFSA and complete all blanks.

The SAI will be a positive or negative number
 - Students may be asked to verify the financial information they provide.
4. **Your entire application must not exceed 4 total SINGLE-SIDED pages:**
 - Pages 1-2...
 - Items must be completed in the space provided—do not write "see attached sheet"
 - You may adjust the height of each text box to accommodate your responses on each page, but do not move items from one page to another
 - You may hand-write and/or type your responses in blue or black ink
 - Please note that spell-check may not work in the text boxes.
 - Page 3...
 - Essay must be **TYPED** in the provided space
 - Your essay will be read by dozens of people, so you may not want to share anything too personal.
 - Page 4...
 - Include a copy of your 7-semester high school transcript
 - Make sure all four of your pages are dark ink/good quality so they will copy well
 - **Paperclip** all pages together (do not staple)
 - Retain this cover page (0) for your records
5. **Completed applications must be submitted to the guidance office no later than 9 a.m. on March 12, 2025.** Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.

The appearance of your application is important.
Your "finished product" should look just like the original application.
