2. Because all applications will be copied, **use black or blue ink** and affix all pages with a **paperclip** (do not staple).
3. DO NOT submit your application in a report cover.
4. **Your entire application must not exceed 4 total SINGLE-SIDED pages.**
 - *Pages 1-2...*
 - *Items must be completed in the space provided—do not write "see attached sheet"*
 - *You may hand-write and/or type your responses (typing is preferred)*
 - *If you type your responses, note that spell-check may not work in the text boxes.*
 - *Page 3...*
 - *Essay must be TYPED*
 - *Page 4...*
 - *Include a copy of your 7-semester high school transcript*
 - *Retain this cover page (0) and the essay instructions for your records*
 - *Make sure all four of your pages are dark/good quality so they will copy well*
5. **Completed applications must be submitted to the guidance office no later than 9 a.m. on [March 21, 2022](#).** Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.

The appearance of your application is important.

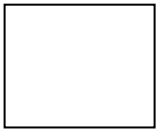
Your "finished product" should look just like the original application.
