## REMINDERS

# Emergency Notification Reminder

This is a reminder that Fort Recovery Local Schools uses the One Call Now system for notifying parents in the event of school delays/cancellations, emergencies, or other serious issues. For example, this could be used in lockdown situations, natural disasters, or student relocation events. This will be especially important as winter weather begins to arrive! All district alerts will be through One Call Now and managed by you through the portal. Using this system, you can set-up your account to receive text alerts, phone calls, and emails. It is strongly recommended that you set-up all three components (text, phone message, email) of your account. You can manage your account or set-up a new one using the instructions below:
