Athletic Facilities Updates

In an effort to streamline the facility reservation process for the public, all requests for FRLS Facilities usage (including gyms, Student Activity Center, EMS Auditoria, Fields, etc.) run through Fort Recovery Local Schools Facilities Director Aimee Pottkotter. All Requests can be submitted by using Fort Recovery Facilities Usage Form on the districts website. The district website also continues the SAC calendar for the public to view for help knowing SAC availability times.

As a reminder, the SAC is off-limits to PK-12 students during home athletic events. When using the SAC, please ensure appropriate language and music are maintained. Access to the SAC outside of scheduled practices requires an individual SAC fob, which cannot be shared between families due to liability reasons. Additionally, any equipment used should be returned to its original storage location.

Attendance

As a reminder, within the last few years that state has changed school attendance policies. You will notice on your child's report card that the attendance is tracked by hours. The state requires schools to record the number of hours a child is absent, no longer does the state track the number of days. In addition to tracking attendance by hours, we are asking that parents supply a medical excuse for absences due to extended illness and/or appointments. Hours absent due to a medically excused reason (provided medical excuse) are 'exempt' from the hours counted towards your child's attendance. Please be sure to ask at doctor, dentist, vision, etc. appointments for an excuse to provide to the Middle School office. If you have any questions regarding your child's attendance and/or attendance procedures, please do not hesitate to call the Middle School.


