## **Guidelines:**

- 1. Applications are **available online** via the school website... High School > Guidance Homepage > Local Scholarship Applications (right side) Be sure to download each application—don't simply "preview" or the formatting will be incorrect.
- 2. The appearance of your application is important! Proofread carefully before turning in, checking for misspelled words, complete sentences, etc. (FYI: Spell check does not work in text boxes.) Use black/blue ink (no pencil).
- 3. Keep the 7-semester transcript you are given so you make copies as needed. Use the 7-semester cumulative GPA & class rank on your transcript for all applications. The pink & yellow packets in your career portfolio should aid you with your applications.
- 4. All applications are due in the Guidance Office by the due date (unless noted otherwise). Late applications will not be accepted unless school is cancelled on the due date. Don't wait—start NOW and submit early.
- Winners will be announced at graduation. If you are lucky enough to receive a scholarship, send a Thank You **Note** to the organization or individual providing the scholarship.
