

Selection Process for the National Honor Society:

Juniors and seniors are eligible to be inducted if they have earned a cumulative 3.5 GPA or higher. The students who met the GPA requirement are notified and asked to complete a NHS Candidate Form. This survey asks students to include a list all high school activities in which they were actively involved, a list of leadership positions held and honors earned, a log of service hours, an essay describing how they provided service to others, and an informational contact form. The names of all eligible students are sent to all high school teachers via a web survey. The teachers are asked to rate each student in the categories of leadership, character, and service. The NHS advisor, who is a non-voting member, tabulates the data and shares the results with the faculty council, a team of five faculty members from different departments, or subject areas. The faculty council uses the data, along with the information supplied by the candidate, to select new inductees.
