Guidelines:

1. The appearance of your application is important! Proofread carefully, checking for misspelled words, complete sentences, etc. (FYI: Spell check does not work in text boxes.)
Keep copies for your applications.
2. Do not use pencil on these (or any) applications. Use black/blue pen or type your responses.
3. STUDENTS are responsible for completing scholarship applications—not parents.
4. **Keep the 7-semester transcript** you are given so you can make copies for your applications (7 of these apps require a transcript). Use the 7- semester cumulative GPA & class rank on your transcript for all applications.
5. Use the pink & yellow packet in your career portfolio to aid you on your applications.
6. Each scholarship listed below has its own unique **application available online** via the school website: *High School > Guidance Homepage > Local Scholarship Applications (right side)*.
Be sure to download each application—don't simply "preview" or the formatting will be incorrect.
7. **Submit 2023 applications.** If an application is on an outdated form or does not have a title, it will not be considered.
8. FRHS cannot guarantee that any/all of these scholarships will be awarded. Dollar amounts are subject to change. In addition, you may need to provide proof of college attendance/grades before receiving your award.
9. Applications must be turned in to the guidance office (unless noted otherwise) by the due date. **Late applications will not be accepted** unless school is cancelled on the due date.
Don't wait-- start your applications NOW.
10. Additional scholarships are available in the FRHS Guidance and Scholarship Newsletter.
11. Winners will be announced at graduation. *If you are lucky enough to receive a scholarship, **send a Thank You Note** to the organization or individual providing the scholarship.*
