- 5. Use the pink & yellow packets in your career portfolio to aid you with your applications.
- 6. Each scholarship listed below has its own unique application available online via the school website: High School > Guidance Homepage > Local Scholarship Applications (right side).
 Be sure to download each application—don't simply "preview" or the formatting will be incorrect.
- 7. **Submit 2024 applications**. If an application is on an outdated form or does not have a title, it will not be considered.
- 8. FRHS cannot guarantee that any/all of these scholarships will be awarded. Dollar amounts are subject to change. In addition, you may need to provide proof of college attendance/grades before receiving your award.
- Applications must be turned in to the guidance office (unless noted otherwise) by the due date.
 Late applications will not be accepted <u>unless</u> school is cancelled on the due date.
 Don't wait-- start your applications NOW.
